

Pilot phase:

The *IN_DIGIT2EU* online course aims to fill the gap and provide an open user-oriented skills development path in the area of internationalisation. The benefits of the online course are high flexibility, but without giving up on the multi-sensory and interaction factor.

This training is addressed to entrepreneurs and SME managers/owners, employees, wannabe entrepreneurs to improve their internationalisation skills.

The pilot course was running in 6 countries (Romania, Portugal, Poland, Lithuanian, Cyprus, Greece). Each partner ensured the engagement of at least 20 participants per country. After the completion of the pilot course, an assessment questionnaire has been completed by the learners. The experience will serve to outline some issues that were still in the preparation phase. The problems detected together with the results of the other partner countries will help to make adjustments to the platform and the content of the course.
